On July 2, 2012, Development Services Staff APPROVED an application for a Neighborhood Use Permit (NUP) for a Wireless Communication Facility (WCF) consisting of 12 antennas mounted on an existing high school building concealed behind radio-frequency transparent materials designed to match adjacent building surfaces. The project is located at 5951 Village Center Loop Road on the Canyon Crest Academy school property.
